Historical Note: Florence Cole Vincent was the granddaughter of famed Hudson River School painter Thomas Cole (b. 1801 - d. 1848). Mrs. Vincent assembled information about her grandfather and his estate and compiled it in this collection which she donated to the Greene County Historical Society. Beyond the Cole family, Mrs. Vincent also included information and papers on the Thompson family of Catskill and their business transactions during the 19th century. The Thompson family originally built Cedar Grove, and it was they who rented studio space to Thomas Cole in the early 1830s.

Summary of Contents: The collection contains a variety of material ranging from news clippings concerning Cole to original works by his children. There is also information about events where Cole's work was exhibited and gleanings about events surrounding his home in the years following his death. There are also several folders containing family papers and correspondence of his descendants and the related Thompsons, in particular an indenture from 1770 which is the oldest item in the collection.

Arrangement: No arrangement standard present, boxes are organized as presented to VRL by the donor.

Acquisition: Gift by family, supporting documentation not present.
